

NEW COMMUNITY SERVICES RECOVERY FUND

The Community Services Recovery Fund (CSRF) is a one-time investment of \$400 million that will help charities and non-profits acquire the tools they need to adapt and modernize so they can better support pandemic recovery in communities across Canada.

In collaboration with Community Foundations of Canada, the Canadian Red Cross and United Way, TCF is proud to be one of the participating foundations to distribute funding.

The CSRF supports Community Service Organizations including non-profit organizations, Indigenous Governing Bodies and Registered Charities located in Canada. Funding will enable organizations to invest in their own organizational capacity and improve the efficacy, accessibility, and sustainability of the community services that they provide.

PROJECT FOCUS AREA

Community foundations across Canada are administering grants specifically for one-time projects under the Project Focus Area: **Investing in Systems and Processes.**

Some examples of projects under this stream include: Investment in contact management systems; Implementation of a new communications plan; Enhancement of a new accounting system; Development, implementation, or adaptation of a new fundraising strategy, and; A governance review through the lens of organizational resilience.
